Order Taker and Cashier Best Bets

ORDER TAKING

- ✓ Respond at the 1st beep
- ✓ Only repeat orders if unsure
- ✓ Refrain from multi-tasking during the peaks. Stay focused on order taking to ensure accuracy
- ✓ For Side by Side, wait to store orders until after the car's front bumper has crossed the merge point line

CASHIERING

- ✓ Look ahead for visual cues of payment type (cash, credit or linked payment)
- ✓ Recall orders quickly be ready with receipt for linked payment orders and direct guest ahead to present booth
- ✓ Refrain from multi-tasking during the peaks
- ✓ If orders are being changed at the cash window, be sure to communicate with order taker if necessary
